2026-27 Chi Alpha Sigma Internship Opportunity

Chi Alpha Sigma is pleased to announce a remote internship opportunity for the 2026-2027 academic year. This internship is open to student-athletes who are inducted into Chi Alpha Sigma, which does include student-athletes from this academic year. The intern will assist in the areas of chapter services, social media management, graphic design, strategic planning, and membership expansion and reactivation with opportunities for professional development and network-building available throughout the year. The 2026-2027 internship is anticipated to begin in September 2026 and continue through April 2027. A maximum of two (2) internships will be offered.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

1. **Social Media Management/Content Creation**

Manage various social media accounts for the organization. Content will include Chi Alpha Sigma news, chapter launch and induction announcements, and relevant recognition posts.

2. **Chapter Services**

Assist member institutions and chapter advisors with information requests as needed. Aid Chi Alpha Sigma staff in collecting induction class data and distributing honoree certificates.

3. **Graphic Design**

Develop unique and professional graphics for posting on social media.

4. **Membership Expansion and Reactivation**

Work with staff on outreach and marketing to institutions who do not have an active Chi Alpha Sigma chapter.

5. **Additional Duties/Projects**

To be assigned by Chi Alpha Sigma staff as needed or requested.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Previously inducted member of Chi Alpha Sigma
- Ability to collaborate with Chi Alpha Sigma stakeholders
- Ability to engage a diverse population through current and prospective member institutions
- Strong organizational skills related to data entry, decision making, and marketing of Chi Alpha Sigma
- Strong time management skills and drive to complete projects unsupervised
- An interest to pursue a career in sports, marketing or communications is helpful but not required.

COMPENSATION

Internship may be taken for degree credit but will also be paid a \$2,000 stipend in monthly payments of \$250 each from September 2026 through April 2027. For those seeking degree credit, they will be responsible for checking with their campus academic advisors to register for the appropriate course and complete required paperwork.
