Chi Alpha Sigma is a nonprofit organization that was established to recognize college studentathletes who excel both on and off the field of competition. The organization was founded in 1996 by then DePauw University head football coach Nick Mourouzis. His goal was to provide outstanding student-athletes with an opportunity to become connected within a fraternal association that aligns their educational and athletic successes for a lifetime.

WHAT WE DO

Chi Alpha Sigma recognizes college studentathletes who receive a varsity letter in their sport, achieve junior academic standing or higher after their fifth full time semester, and earn a 3.4 or higher cumulative grade point average. Studentathletes who compete for a collegiate club team are also eligible if the club team is overseen by the athletics department at the local chapter. DID YOU KNOW

HOW TO ESTABLISH A CHAPTER
